Just a polite reminder that parents refrain from using the reception area as a walk through. This is a safeguarding and health and safety issue.

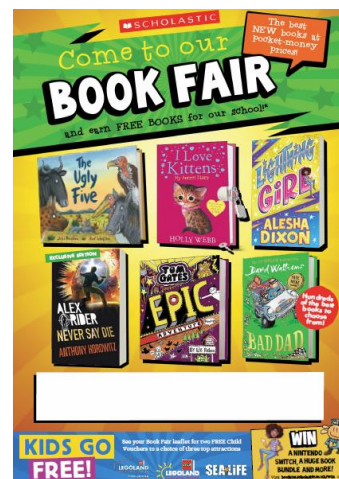
