

Coronavirus Catch up Premium 2020/21

The government has provided schools with additional funding in the academic year 20/21 as a result of coronavirus. Each school will be allocated funds on a per pupil basis, providing £80 for each pupil from Reception to Year 11. At October 2020 there were 894 pupils on roll from Reception to Year 11. The money allocated to Ark Kings is expected to be £71,520.

These funds are used to support pupils and to catch up for lost learning over the previous months.

2. Employ an English GTA to support KS4 pupils for five days a week	£22,035
3. Employ a Humanities GTA to support KS4 pupils one day a week	£4,407
4. Contributions to salary of 2 TA's to support learning across KS3 classes	£53,820
5. Contributions to printing of resources for home learning across the academy in order to provide continuity of provisions.	£10,000
6. Contributions to tutoring for pupils in Year 11/Year 6.	£1,000
7. Contributions to running holiday catch up.	£5,000
