Drawing		<p>Find something SPIKEY at home to draw from, eg . a hairbrush, toothbrush, fork, cactus...</p> <p>Using pencil or pen, draw this object as accurately as you can, demonstrating at least 6 different tones from dark to light</p>
Drawing		<p>Find something SHINY at home to draw from eg. Saucepan, glass bottles, apples, jewellery...</p> <p>Use pen or pencil to copy this as accurately as you can, use soft lines to show the shiny surface and show at least 6 tones.</p>
Drawing		<p>Find something SOFT at home to draw from, eg. clothing, teddy bear, pet...</p> <p>Use pen or pencil to copy this accurately, demonstrating the texture through your pencil strokes.</p>
